IN a recent column, Peter Singer, who is a Professor of Bioethics at Princeton, wrote that while John Stuart Mill argued that individuals are the best guardians of their own interests, research suggests that they can do with some help. He took the example of Professor of Economics at Yale, Dean Karlan, who looked at ways of helping some of the poorest people in the Philippines to achieve their goals.
