Proposal Instructions, Round VII (Winter 2021)



Overview

IPA's Peace and Recovery (P&R) program has launched its seventh Call for Proposals. Proposals are due November 2021. Those interested in applying are asked to first read the P&R Pegram's <u>Guiding Principles and Funding Princip</u>

The P&R Program will consider the following types of proposals:

- Bit Program will consider the tollowing types of propositi: Exploratory grants: These grants are to develop preliminary means hides. The expectation is that these grants help researchers develop subsequent proposals for pilots or full randomized controlled trials (RCIs). Activities may include travel, relationship develop ment, descriptive analysis, observational analysis, and data development or collection. These gins this are earme fixed for justice faculty, PID students, and other meanchers who do not have other sources of funding for ta veliand exploratory work. Tensued professors from major research universities are storogly discouraged from applying for these start-up funds. Awards are between 51,000 and 50,000.

Pilot budies: These grants are for studies with a clear research question, but for which the design and implementation requires substantial upfront investments. The expectation is that this work helps research develop subsequent proposals for full RCLs. Awards are between \$5,000 and \$20,000.

The funding could be used to embed a research staff member in an organization, produce preliminary scoping exercises to ensure interventions are context-appropriate, host matchmaking events or conferences, or other activities that achieve similar aims. Awards are capped at \$25,000.
